EVENT REGISTRATION

Pre-registration is highly recommended to participate at all IJSBA sanctioned watercross event. Events need to run efficiently and on time and that means that pre-registration is vital to streamlining the event weekend. Riders may enter via mail or online registration. Entry fees are listed on the entry form and below. All mail in and online registrations must be received by Thursday, May 27th. All others will be considered late and be charged a late fee of \$20 per class. Pre-registration benefits you in the wallet and will get you off on the right foot to a great day of racing!

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Online Registration can be done online by going to the "Race Registration" page on the UWP site. Find the link for Syracuse which will lead to online registration, please remember that registration is not completed until payment has been made through PayPal. If you do not want to use PayPal, please mail your entry form to arrive no later than Thursday, May 27th to avoid late charges.

PRINTED ENTRY FORMS: If you mailed entry form must be accompanied with payment for entry fees and IJSBA membership if necessary. Personal checks, money orders, cash and credit cards are acceptable forms of payment - please mail your entry form to arrive no later than Thursday, May 27th to avoid late charges.

NOTE:

1. Please note that accepting Credit Cards is a service to the racers; anyone intentionally providing wrong information on declined credit cards will be required to pay cash at all future UWP events.
2. *Pre-registered racers who add classes at the race site will also incur a \$10 late fee per class.* It is easier to remove you from a class, then to enter you into a class – if you are unsure, you can always register and then withdrawal! We will refund your money in the method that you originally paid in.
3. Race orders will not be changed unless it is an error on UWP's part, if you do not pre-register you may run the risk of back to back races.

ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The 2010 IJSBA Watercross National Tour is sanctioned and governed by the IJSBA and run according to the IJSBA rulebook. All participants must be a current IJSBA competition member and must present proof of valid membership to compete. Please bring your IJSBA membership cards with you.

Safety Gear

A properly fitting full coverage helmet, with chin and mouth protection (face shield removed), that meets current DOT or SNELL M-rated standard, must be worn at all times while on the water. A U.S. Coast Guard-approved Type III life personal floatation device (PFD), in sound condition, must also be worn at all times while on the water, including during practice. Fines will be assessed to all riders in violation of these rules. Wetsuits, protective footwear and eyewear are highly recommended.

Racing Numbers

You must have two sets of race numbers, with the correct color backgrounds on your boat – one on each side in the front of the watercraft. If you do not have the proper numbers and backgrounds on your watercraft you will not pass safety inspection. Racing numbers must be black, a minimum of 7 inches high, and spaced at least ½ inch apart. Standard block-type numbers, without shading or outlining, must be used. If there are duplicate race numbers in your class, you may be asked to change your number during the riders meeting. New or replacement numbers & letters will be available at registration.

Important Notice If there is a duplicate number problem in a class, you may be asked to place an “X” after your number.

Pre-Race Safety Inspection

In the interest of safety, IJSBA rules require that all watercraft receive a complete safety inspection before being allowed on the water. Every participant is required to have his/her watercraft tech inspected and it is the responsibility of the rider to submit his/her watercraft to the Technical Director for safety inspection. See below for the check-in/safety inspection times for your class(es). Tech inspection is to check to see if your boat is safe to go on the water – not to see if it is legal for class participation.

Event Sign In/Check In

Whether pre-registered or not, every participant is required to check in, show their membership card, sign the waiver and release and get a wristband. This includes all racers, holders and mechanics that will be participating in the event. See schedule of events for check-in time.

Riders Meetings

It is mandatory that all participants attend the published riders meeting at the scheduled time for each of the classes entered. Roll call will be taken to insure that everyone’s smiling faces will be in attendance.

Sponsor Decals

In consideration of sponsor commitment and support of this event, participants will be required to display a TOYOTA decal, as well as IJSBA stickers, on each side of his or her boat. Stickers will be available to participants at registration. Competitors not displaying required decals on their boats will not be eligible for any contingency money.

Post-Race Tech Inspection

Every participant that finishes the race and receives the checkered flag, must immediately proceed to the tech inspection area, and submit their watercraft for inspection. Failure to submit your watercraft for inspection may cause you to be disqualified. Please bring your tools and expect to have your boat down.

Event Parking

Competitors will receive parking passes to enter into the park, you will be expected to stay in the park until the completion of days racing due to the heavy foot traffic in the area.

Pit Vehicles

Because of the tremendous number of people that will be attending these National Tour events, pit vehicle rules will be strictly enforced. ATV's, Mules, golf carts, beach carts, etc. will be allowed to transport equipment to the beach. There will be a 5-mile per hour speed limit set and it will be strictly enforced for all ATV's, Mules, golf carts, Go-Peds, Scooters, etc. Fines will be assessed to those breaking this rule. All pit vehicles must remain in the pit area and follow the correct pathway to the race area. Please observe the speed limit signs and watch out for pedestrians and do not wreck this privilege for all racers. Those racers abusing the privilege will be fined and/or have their pit vehicle impounded.

Tow Loops

All watercraft are required to have a tow loop on the front of their watercraft. Watercraft without a tow loop or piece of strong rope will not pass safety inspection and thus not be allowed to race or practice.

Awards

The prestigious IJSBA Watercross National tour awards will be awarded to the top 3 riders in the 30 different classes. Pro-Am and Expert racers will also receive a cash award (50% cash payback) plus a purse for selected classes. Riders that do not pick up their awards can have them mailed to them for a handling fee plus the cost of shipping. Awards not claimed by July 1, 2009 will be forfeited.

ONONDAGA LAKE PARK RULES

Park statement

1. Vehicles are not permitted on the recreation trail without a proper permit. See map for details, refer to Appendix A.
2. ATV's are to be used only to transport watercraft to and from designated launch area and must stay at a speed below 10mph at all times.
3. **Tent Camping is not allowed.**
4. *RV campers and trailers are allowed only in designated areas. Utilities are not available. Anyone arriving after hours may be asked to move their RV and trailer to a designated area please be cooperative.*
5. Quiet hours for on-site RV Campers will be in affect after 10pm.
6. No open fires

Alcoholic Beverage Policy

1. Onondaga County Parks places top priority on the safe and legal use of alcoholic beverages.
2. No person under the legal drinking age may possess or consume alcoholic beverages in Onondaga County Parks.
3. Alcoholic beverage consumption or open containers of alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all Park parking lots or areas used for parking.
4. Beer and soda must be in plastic, cans or kegs. **Glass containers are prohibited.**
5. Alcohol may be brought in, dispensed and consumed ONLY in the area for which you have been assigned during the event unless purchased from vendors during event hours.

-  1: EXIT 39 toward FAIRGROUNDS/SYRACUSE Merge onto I-690 East
-  2: EXIT 4: Take the JOHN GLENN BLVD
-  3: Stay STRAIGHT to go onto JOHN GLENN BLVD/CR-81 E.
-  4: Turn RIGHT onto LONG BRANCH RD/CR-35.
-  5: Follow to Willow Bay turn right & enter slowly into Onondaga Lake Park

Direction from I-90 West Bound

-  1: Merge onto I-90 W toward BUFFALO (Portions toll).
-  2: EXIT 38, toward LIVERPOOL/SYRACUSE
-  3: Keep RIGHT at the fork to go on OSWEGO ST/CR-57/CR-91.
-  4: Turn RIGHT onto MEYERS RD.
-  5: Turn RIGHT onto COLD SPRINGS RD/NY-370.
-  6: Turn LEFT onto LONG BRANCH RD/CR-35. Continue to follow CR-35.
-  7: Follow to Willow Bay turn left & enter slowly into Onondaga Lake Park

-  Start out going SOUTHEAST on WINCHELL RD/CR-162 toward WALTERS RD/CR-221.
-  Turn LEFT onto WALTERS RD/CR-221. Continue to follow CR-221.
-  Turn LEFT onto STATE FAIR BLVD/VAN VLECK RD/CR-80.
-  Merge onto I-690 W via the ramp on the LEFT toward NEW YORK THRUWAY.
-  Take the JOHN GLENN BLVD exit, EXIT 4.
-  Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto JOHN GLENN BLVD/CR-81 E.
-  Turn RIGHT onto LONG BRANCH RD/CR-35.
-  Follow to Willow Bay turn left & Enter slowly into Onondaga Lake Park
